
The cactus family gained several new offsets as well!





...maybe the lighting is so bad you're not sure if you took it at night in a closet under a blanket with your eyes closed.


...maybe you forgot to focus the actual plant and now we can see your dirty room (this might be too close to home...)

"Title. Some field and greenhouse techniques for photographing succulent plants

Short summary: This talk will show some relatively simple techniques for improving your photography of succulent plants, whether in the field or in a greenhouse (or your backyard). I will show examples of different techniques and demonstrate a few pieces of "hardware" that can help improve your photographic results. Whether your camera is a cell phone or a sophisticated full-frame digital camera the techniques we demonstrate can (hopefully) help your photographic results."
